FORMATTING GUIDELINES

The author is responsible for the quality and content of the thesis. All the texts of scientific reports these will be checked for illegal borrowings to ensure compliance with academic integrity standards. The organising committee reserves the right of internal review and selection of theses to be included in the collection. The length of the abstract is 2-3 pages in A5 format, MSWord editor (.doc / .docx). Margins: left, top and bottom – 20 mm, right – 10 mm. Times New Roman font, font size 10, single space, paragraph – 10 mm. Each table, illustration and diagram must be signed and named. The source should be indicated under the tables and figures. Formulas should be printed using the Microsoft Equation formula editor and numbered in parentheses on the right. The list of references should contain only the sources to which there are references in the text. Example of link: (Ivanov et al., 2020). References to different sources in parentheses should be given through a semicolon. Example of link: (Ivanov et al., 2020; Hassan et al., 2014). The list of references should be presented in APA Style.

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACTS

The title of abstracts in capital bold is in the centre. The author's status (applicant, graduate student, associate professor, doctoral student, professor, etc.) is placed through the blank line on the right, following the author's (authors') surname and name in bold. Then, the organisation's name is on the following row on the right. The text of the thesis follows through an empty line. The references (if necessary) are in a row after the main text (font size 8)
