FORMATTING GUIDELINES

The author is responsible for the quality and content of the thesis.

All the texts of scientific reports theses will be checked for illegal borrowings to ensure compliance with academic integrity standards. The organising committee reserves the right of internal review and selection of theses to be included in the collection.

The text must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 10, with intervals of 1 and margins: left, top and bottom – 20 mm, right – 10 mm. The volume of material in A5 format is 2-3 pages, in the file format of MS Word (.doc / .docx). The tables and figures should have a title and number. Notes are placed directly below the table, and the source is indicated (compiled by the source or by the author). In front of the tables and figures, there should be a reference to it in the text. Formulas should be printed using the Microsoft Equation formula editor and numbered in parentheses on the right. The list of references should contain only the sources to which there are references in the text. Example of reference: (Shevchenko et al., 2025). References to different sources in parentheses should be given through a semicolon. Example of reference: (Shevchenko et al., 2025; Hassan et al., 2024). The list of references should be presented in APA Style.

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACTS

The title of abstracts in capital bold is in the centre. The author's status (applicant, graduate student, associate professor, doctoral student, professor, etc.) is placed through the blank line on the right, following the author's (authors') surname and name in bold. Then, the organisation's name is on the following row on the right. The text of the thesis follows through an empty line. The references (if necessary) are in a row after the main text (font size 8)
